## TRUNK INVENTORY – FUR TRADE

\_\_\_ **WOOL TRADE BLANKET**- a very important item that denoted prestige

### IRON TOOLS:

- \_\_\_ Iron Hook- used as pot hook and also worn on a belt as a status symbol
- \_\_\_ Flint- for starting fires

### TRADE SILVER:

- \_\_\_ Brooch- often worn by the voyageurs on their caps
- \_\_\_ Bracelets- used for personal adornment

### DECORATIONS:

- \_\_\_ Bone Buttons
- \_\_\_ Seed Beads
- \_\_\_ 1 Blue and 1 Purple strand of pony beads

### FURS:

- \_\_\_ Beaver, Coyote, Skunk, Badger, Raccoon, Fischer, Mink, Opossum, Muskrat, River Otter

### FUR TRADER'S BELONGINGS:

- \_\_\_ Chocolate
- \_\_\_ Tavern Clay pipe box & Clay pipe
- \_\_\_ Red Shirt
- \_\_\_ Red hat
- \_\_\_ Hat- blue with silver brooch (The pelican was the voyager sign or mascot)
- \_\_\_ Multicolored sashes (2)
